Meeting of the Board of Overseers September 8, 2018 – 10:00 AM Approved October 13, 2018

The Board of Overseers met at 10:00 AM at the Brewer Cottage, Bustins Island, ME on Saturday, September 8, 2018. Overseers present were: Tanya **Sweatt**, Chairman; Robert **Boone**, Vice Chairman; Judy **Hayes**, and Mandy **Meyer**. Other officers/appointees/ contractors present were Sue **Spalding**, Clerk; Tony **DeBruyn**, Treasurer; Pat **LaFleur**, Administrative Assistant; Linda **Sweatt**, Secretary; Crawford and Candy **Taisey** from Straight Edge Construction, Superintendent.

MINUTES

(1) ACTION: A motion was made (Boone), seconded (Hayes), and unanimously voted to accept the minutes as amended for the meeting held August 8, 2018.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Pat LaFleur presented the Board with a Public Playground Safety Handbook with a picture of the playground equipment which will be gifted to Bustins Island. She requested that this playground equipment be allowed to be installed by McVety's Hearth and Home of Yarmouth in the spring of 2019 in the playground area where the volleyball court is presently. All costs will be paid by grateful contributions.

(2) ACTION: A motion was made (Sweatt), seconded (Boone), and unanimously voted to allow the new playground equipment be installed by McVety's Hearth and Home of Yarmouth in the spring where the volleyball court presently is.

CLERK'S REPORT – Sue Spalding

Sue informed the Board members that four, large, 4-drawer filing cabinets have been moved to the storage facility in Falmouth. She stated that BIVC needs a legal size, locking, filing cabinet and may need a larger storage unit. John Wood will give the BIVC a large, wood, file cabinet with all the files he has.

Sue mentioned the need for the safe deposit box which presently stores mostly deeds. Tony suggested keeping the safe deposit box for another year.

TREASURER'S REPORT – Tony DeBruyn

Tony distributed the Balance Sheet and Funds Activity and explained the individual bank accounts and the money market accounts. He reminded members that the Capital Maintenance Fund is the money put aside for capital projects and maintenance, such as the Steamer Dock work done this past spring and the Golf Course landing area, which will be the next large project. The Casco Fund is a disaster fund and any expense must be approved at the Annual Meeting.

Tony presented the Check Register Report for 7/27/2018 through 9/4/2018 noting a few expenses and the transfer of \$15,000.00 into the Capital Maintenance Fund.

(3) ACTION: A motion was made (Sweatt), seconded (Boone), and unanimously voted to authorize the payment of checks written and submitted by the Treasurer in the Register Report dated 9/4/2018 for the period 7/27/2018 through 9/4/2018.

Tony reviewed the Statement of Revenues, Expenditures and Transfers explaining the Forecast and Variance to Budget columns.

Tony said he was appointing Judy Hayes and Hank Rauch as Deputy Treasurers. He requested the Board approve the Treasurer's Authority and Disbursement Policy.

(4) ACTION: A motion was made (Sweatt), seconded (Boone), and unanimously voted to approve the Treasurer's Authority and Disbursement Practices Policy.

APPOINTED OFFICIALS' and COMMITTEE REPORTS:

ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT - Pat LaFleur

Pat LaFleur mentioned the following reminders:

- (3) Reminder that all new appointments and reappointments to Boards and Committees must be approved.

- (5) ACTION: A motion was made (Sweatt), seconded (Boone), and unanimously vote to approve the following Order to close Bustins roads: Following a public hearing pursuant to Title 23 MRSA section 2953(2), and authorized by the voters of the Bustins Island Village Corporation at their Annual Meeting on August 2, 2008, and voted unanimously by the Board of Overseers at their meeting on the 8th of September 2018, the undersigned Chairman of the Board of Overseers of the Bustins Island Village Corporation, Maine hereby orders all Bustins Island roads closed from November I, 2018 through April 30, 2019.

SUPERINTENDENT – Crawford Taisey

Vehicle and Equipment – Crawford stated that the ATV was at Chad Little undergoing clutch work. He is looking into repairing the island weed whacker or purchasing a new one. The island chain saw needs a new bar and chain.

Public Boat Ramp at the Golf Course – The quote from Plante for this work must be updated. Along with the cash grant, the state offered to supply the planks. The state planks do not meet the specifications in the Walsh design, so the BIVE will purchase the sturdier planks as planned.

File Cabinets – Crawford reported that the very heavy filing cabinets have been transported to the mainland with the help of Matthew and Jayne Rowe.

Unauthorized Structure – Crawford informed the Board that John Carrier III has cleaned the platform and the structure is gone.
