## **Truck Driver Job Description**

The Island Truck Driver is appointed annually by the Board of Overseers and is responsible to the Board of Overseers.

- 1) Job Requirements:
  - a) Must be at last 16 years of age
  - b) Must have a valid US driver's license
  - c) Must be able to lift 40lbs
- 2) Schedule:
  - a) Begin with first scheduled Bustins Ferry trip, usually a week before Memorial Day Weekend
  - b) End with the last scheduled trip, usually Columbus Day Weekend
  - c) Regular hours run parallel to the ferry schedule, but may be adjusted based on demonstrated demand
  - d) On call as needed
- 3) Duties and Responsibilities:
  - a) Familiarize themselves with emergency facilities, procedures, personnel and communications
  - b) Learn to operate fire-fighting equipment and participate in fire training exercises
  - c) Familiarize themselves with the first aid supply room (first aid knowledge is recommended)
  - d) Monitor the truck phone for emergency calls on 24 hours by 7-day basis
  - e) Carry Emergency Response Beeper
  - f) Meet all regularly scheduled Bustins Ferry arrivals at the public dock
  - g) Meet special Bustins Ferry trips during regular hours
  - h) Transport baggage, passengers and freight to and from the public dock to Islanders' cottages or other requested locations on the Island
  - i) Make miscellaneous pick-ups and deliveries of passengers, baggage or freight during regular hours and when given reasonable notice
  - j) Meet private boats and transport baggage, passengers and freight during regular hours and when given reasonable notice
  - k) Maintain a truck usage log in the Island truck
  - 1) Arrange for an Alternate Driver when not available to perform duties and notify Superintendent prior to coverage
  - m) Pay Alternate Driver for duties covered
  - n) Comply with all provisions of the current motor vehicle and equipment use policies that apply to the Island vehicles
  - o) Operate the Island vehicle in a safe manner and at moderate speeds not to exceed 10 MPH at all times
  - p) Be responsible for unlocking and locking public wells in accordance with the well schedule as provided by the Superintendent or Water Commissioner
- 4) Alternate Drivers:
  - a) Must meet all the requirements of the Truck Driver's job
  - b) Must be willing to perform all the duties of the Truck Driver
