

Bustins Island Public Space Protocols

Effective June 27, 2020

Essential Public Spaces

Fire Barn/Fire Equipment

- Available in the event of a fire or other island emergency

Honey Wagon

- Available by appointment; contact Crawford Taisey, Island Superintendent
- Follow safety protocols: mask, gloves, social distancing

Island Tractor & Trucks

- Island Tractor and Trucks may only be used by authorized Island Employees, including Island Superintendent, Island Truck Driver and Island Trash Collector
- Available to support transport in case of emergency

Public Dock/Float

- Open for boat landing and departure; do not loiter after gear & passengers are dropped off; follow safety protocols: masks, social distancing, leash pets
- Closed for fishing, swimming & other activities during Lilly B & private boat operations

Public Outhouses

- Closed until further notice; high risk area for virus transmission

Public Wells

- Use at own risk; follow safety protocols: mask, gloves, social distancing
- Do not use any cleaning products on or near the pumps. Be careful not to touch the spigot. Return home and thoroughly wash hands or use hand sanitizer.

Safety Room

- Available in the event of an island emergency

Other Public Spaces

Beaches/Steamer Dock

- Use at own risk; follow safety protocols: wear mask when unable to stay at least 6-feet away from non-household members

Bustins Island Historical Society

- Closed until further notice; small confined space

Brewer Cottage

- Closed until further notice; small confined space

Community House

- Closed until further notice
- Porch is open; use at own risk, follow safety protocols: wear mask when unable to stay 6-feet away from non-household members

Golf Course

- Open for golf; use at own risk; follow safety protocols: wear mask when unable to stay at least 6-feet away from non-household members
- Play in twosomes unless all are members of the same household

Library

- Closed until further notice; small confined space

Nature Center

- Closed for the season

Playground

- Use at own risk, follow safety protocols: wear mask when unable to stay at least 6-feet away from non-household members

Post Office

- Closed for the season
- Mail can be forwarded to Bustins for pick up at South Freeport Post Office

Rope Swing

- Use at own risk; follow safety protocols: wear mask when unable to stay at least 6-feet away from non-household members

School House

- Closed until further notice; small confined space

Tennis Courts

- Closed until annual maintenance can be performed

General Protocols

PHYSICAL DISTANCING AND GOOD HYGIENE TO PREVENT THE SPREAD OF DISEASE

- Wash your hands frequently
- Do not touch your face
- When out of the home remain at least 6-feet apart from other persons (social distancing)
- Wear a face covering when in public to reduce risk of spreading the disease
- If you do not feel well, have a fever or other symptoms (cough, tiredness, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, muscle aches, chills, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, headache, chest pain, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea) of the virus do not go out in public
- Gatherings of more than 50 people are prohibited (until September 1)
