

Public Safety Committee end of year report, 2020

- 1 On July 14 the Maine Forest Service in concert with the Safety Committee provided a full day of chipping on Bustins Island
- 2 Later in July Forest Ranger Kent Nelson spent 1/2 day doing home property fire Inspections
- 3 During this upcoming Fall Ranger Nelson will be hosting a safety day on-line to which all islanders will be invited
- 4 Equipment: Superintendent Crawford Taisey has identified that the water pump connected to the Lafleur large well has failed and needs to be replaced. This is estimated by the Committee to be budgeted at \$5,000. A second water pump issue is at the Leland dock. This pump needs have a system designed so that the pump can be located 20' from a water source. The committee will be working on this over the winter season. The AED needs new pads and possibly a new battery. The committee is looking into options.
- 5 COVID 19-In Cooperation and under advisement from Freeport Fire Department the committee developed evacuation and/or quarantine protocols should an islander(s) develop symptoms.
- 6 Medical and Fire emergencies requiring off site assistance. To this date there have been none including Covid 19.
