Fire Prevention and Education

We're all anticipating a wonderful summer together on Bustins and we'd like to urge you to give fire prevention a high priority. Here are some initial suggestions as you open your cottage this season.

- Have you got enough smoke/carbon monoxide alarms in your cottage? Bring **fresh batteries** for the alarms - *then, install them!*
- Know where your **fire extinguishers** are located. Be certain they are in good working order. The dial should be on green. It's wise to turn fire extinguishers over and back a few times after standing all winter.
- Attach **outside hoses** when you arrive. For those with pressurized water systems, outside hoses can be a first line of defense.
- As Ron Sweatt has reminded us over and over **refrigerator exhaust** systems should be cleaned regularly. How long has it been since you had this done?
- Confirm that your list of **emergency numbers** is correct, readable and quickly accessible. Program these numbers into your cell phone. Know your cottage number for quick emergency identification.

- Oh yes, among the early tasks in opening up, remember (if you use one) to take off your **chimney cap!** Have you followed through on having your chimney cleaned and, if recommended, lined?
